PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy explains privacy practices of **Lucky Laika Distribution OÜ** and applies when Lucky Laika Distribution OÜ processes Your personal data related to Your use of the VOD Platform.

This Privacy Policy may be subject to change from time to time, without prior written notice, taking effect upon making the changes available on the VOD Platform. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully to understand our practices regarding Your personal data and how we will collect and may use and disclose Your personal data.

1. **DEFINITIONS**

"Content"	means any films, live events and/or other content made available on the VOD Platform;				
"LLD"	means Lucky Laika Distribution OÜ, a company registered in Estonia, registry code: 16282680, address: Estonia pst 9, Tallinn 10143, Estonia, e-mail: info@firebirdmovie.com				
"VOD Platform"	means the video on demand platform operated by LLD, which enables to make the Content available to the Users by way of providing TVOD services;				
"TVOD"	means transactional video on demand, referring to the paid exploitation of content for temporary use by the User by way of streaming;				
"Order"	means the declaration of intent of the User to purchase the right to view the selected Content on the VOD Platform in accordance with these Terms and Conditions;				
"data controller"	means a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data. In the context of this Privacy Policy, data controller means LLD, unless explicitly stated otherwise;				
"data processor"	means a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which processes personal data on behalf of the data controller;				
"data subject"	mean the natural person end users of the VOD Platform (consumers);				
"GDPR"	means Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation);				
"personal data"	means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (data subject); an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular on

"Sales Contract"	means the contract concluded between the User and LLD in accordance with these Terms and Conditions for receiving the right to review the Content on the VOD Platform by way of TVOD;

2. WHAT PERSONAL DATA WE MAY PROCESS?

- 2.1 Personal data LLD may process about You if You use our services, VOD Platform or Website may include the following data:
 - 2.1.1 general personal information: name, age, gender;
 - 2.1.2 contact information: e-mail address; mailing address; phone number;
 - 2.1.3 <u>payment information:</u> payment methods and amounts paid in relation to the use of our services;
 - 2.1.4 <u>usage information</u>: information on how our services, VOD Platform or Website are used, including feedback provided;
 - 2.1.5 <u>technical information</u>: technical information collected during Your use of services, VOD Platform or Website such as your IP address or information collected through

cookies (please also see LLD Cookie Policy for further information about data collected through the use of cookies);

2.2 More detailed overview of the personal data LLD processes is provided in the Section 5 below.

3. ON WHAT LEGAL BASIS WE RELY WHEN PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA?

- 3.1 LLD may process personal data of the User for the purpose of being able to provide the services in accordance with LLD Terms and Conditions. Legal basis for such data processing is GDPR Article 6-1-(b), i.e. processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract
- 3.2 LLD may process personal data when processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which LLD is subject. Legal basis for such data processing is GDPR Article 6-1-(c). As an example, LLD may need to process collect and process personal to comply with accounting regulations and tax obligations. LLD also relies on legal obligation as a valid legal basis for data processing, when we are obligated to transfer personal data to relevant authorities on the basis of their valid requests (such as to the court on the basis of valid court order).
- 3.3 LLD may process personal data where processing of personal data is necessary for the purpose of legitimate interests pursued by LLD or other controller, if appropriate. For example, we may process statistical and/or aggregated data on how our services, VOD Platform or Website are used to improve and further develop our services, VOD Platform or Website so that we can provide a better user experience in future. Legal basis for such data processing is GDPR Article 6-1-(f). Additionally, LLD may rely on the legitimate interest to establish, exercise and defend legal claims, to handle complaints or for administrative purposes. When relying on a legitimate interest as a legal basis, LLD ensures that processing is proportionate and that we have carried out proper legitimate interest impact assessment, if necessary.
- 3.4 LLD may process personal data based on the consent granted by the User. Legal basis for such data processing is GDPR Article 6-1-(a). In those situations, we process personal data on the terms as provided in the consent that has been granted to us by each User. If you have granted a consent for data processing, the types and categories of personal data we transfer, the specific recipient(s) of the personal data and other appropriate and relevant information are provided in the specific consent that may be asked from you.
- 3.5 More detailed overview of the legal bases LLD relies on when processing personal data is provided in the Section 5 below.

4. HOW LONG IS PERSONAL DATA RETAINED?

- 4.1 LLD does not retain personal data longer than it is necessary for the purposes of processing personal data or pursuant to applicable law. As a general rule, LLD applies the following retention periods.
- 4.2 Personal data related to contracts can be retained during the term of the contract and based on LLD legitimate interest pursuant to Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR until the end of the statutory limitation periods under applicable law. Accordingly, as a general rule LLD retains User data collected in relation to the provision of the services as long as it is necessary for the provision of the service during the term of the Sales Contract and for 3 years after the termination of such agreement.
- 4.3 Personal data collected on the basis of the consent will be retained until the withdrawal of the consent or in accordance with the terms of specific consent.

- 4.4 Personal data related accounting source documents and accounting journals must be retained in accordance with the relevant accounting laws. LLD must retain accounting documents for 7 years.
- **4.5** More specific details about the retention periods are provided in Section 5 below.

6. WHEN DO WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

- 6.1 LLD may share User personal data with certain third parties service providers e.g. IT suppliers, other service providers or co-operation partners.
- 6.2 LLD may also share User personal data with third parties if LLD is legally required to do so, for example if personal data is requested from us by any authority competent to ask such data in accordance with applicable law.
- 6.3 LLD may also share your personal data with third parties if you have granted your consent for that for specific transfer or based on other appropriate legal basis (for example, performance of a contract or legitimate interest).
- 6.4 LLD may transfer User personal data to third countries, i.e. countries outside the EU/EEA area, for the purposes explained in this Privacy Policy. When transferring User personal data to third countries, LLD will ensure that the transfer is subject to appropriate safeguards under the GDPR and that User rights are protected, such as the Commission's model contracts for the transfer of personal data to third countries (i.e., the standard contractual clauses). User

may request a copy of the safeguards we have put in place with respect to the transfer of personal data by contacting LLD via contact details below.

- 6.6 LLD may also share personal data in connection with business transfers, such as any reorganization, restructuring, merger or sale, or other transfer of assets, provided that the receiving party agrees to protect Your personal data in accordance with this Privacy Policy.
- 6.7 LLD may also share anonymized User data and/or statistical data with third parties, for example for research purposes. Please be noted that in cases where we share anonymized User data and/or statistical data we make sure that no personal data is shared (which means

that no User can be identifiable) and therefore personal data processing regulation and the GDPR shall not apply to such transfers (as no personal data is shared).

7. HOW DOES LLD PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

7.1 To protect User personal data from unauthorized access, unlawful processing or disclosure, accidental loss, modification or destruction, LLD uses appropriate technical and organisational measures that comply with applicable laws. These measures include but are not limited to the implementation of appropriate computer security systems, protection of paper and electronic format files by technical and logical means, controlling and limiting access to documents and buildings.

8. COOKIE POLICY

A. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

- 8.1 Cookies are small text files that are placed on Your computer or other device (such as smartphone, tablet, etc) by websites that You visit. 9. DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS

- 9.1 LLD is dedicated ensuring that all data subject rights arising under applicable law are always guaranteed to the User. In particular, any User who is a data subject has:
 - 9.1.1 the right to access the personal data processed about him/her;
 - 9.1.2 the right to request that rectification of any inaccurate personal data about him/her;
 - 9.1.3 the right to request erasure of personal data and/or restrict of processing of personal data if personal data is processed without a valid legal basis for processing;
 - 9.1.4 the right to receive processed personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and have the right to transmit personal data to another controller;
 - 9.1.5 the right to object to the processing of personal data;
 - 9.1.6 If the User believes that his/her rights have been infringed, the User may contact and lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority applicable for the User jurisdiction (Data Protection Inspectorate in Estonia address Tatari 39, Tallinn 10134, info@aki.ee or other competent authority in the User jurisdiction. List of national Data Protection Authorities in EU is available at https://edpb.europa.eu/about-edpb/board/members_en).

10. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

This Privacy Policy will be governed by the substantive law of Estonia, unless the mandatory provisions applicable to consumers provide for a different governing law. If the respective dispute resulting from this Privacy Policy cannot be settled by negotiations, then the dispute will be finally solved in Harju County Court in Tallinn, Estonia, unless the mandatory provisions applicable to

consumers provide for a different jurisdiction. Data subjects may also lodge complaint to relevant Data Protection Authority (see Section on Data Subject Rights above).
